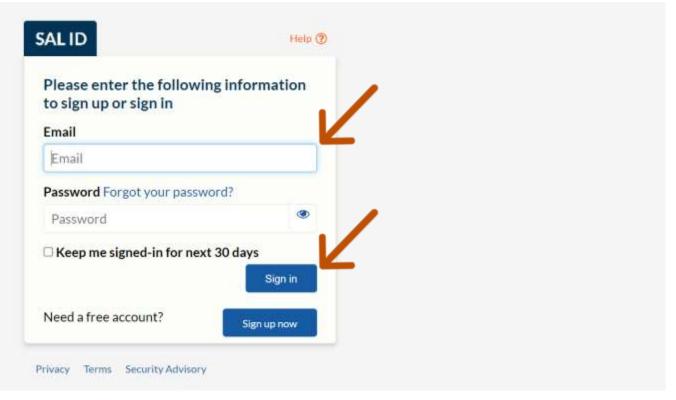

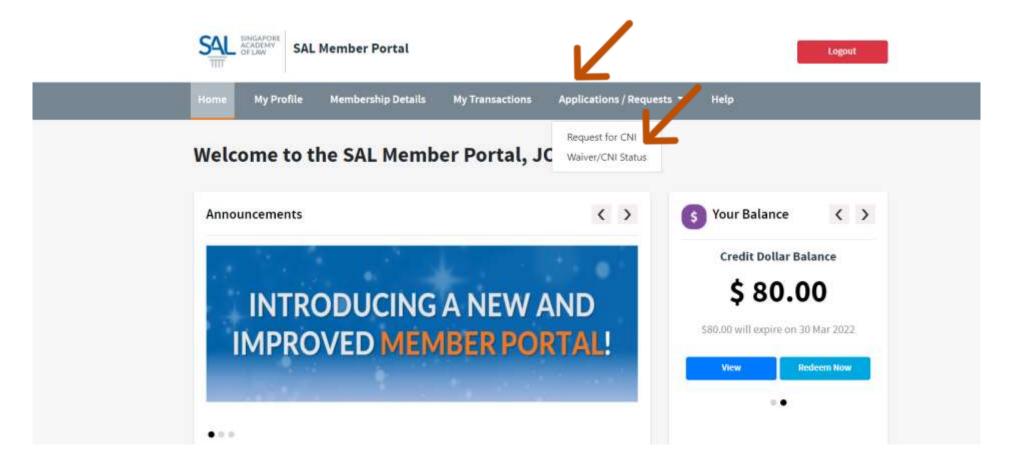

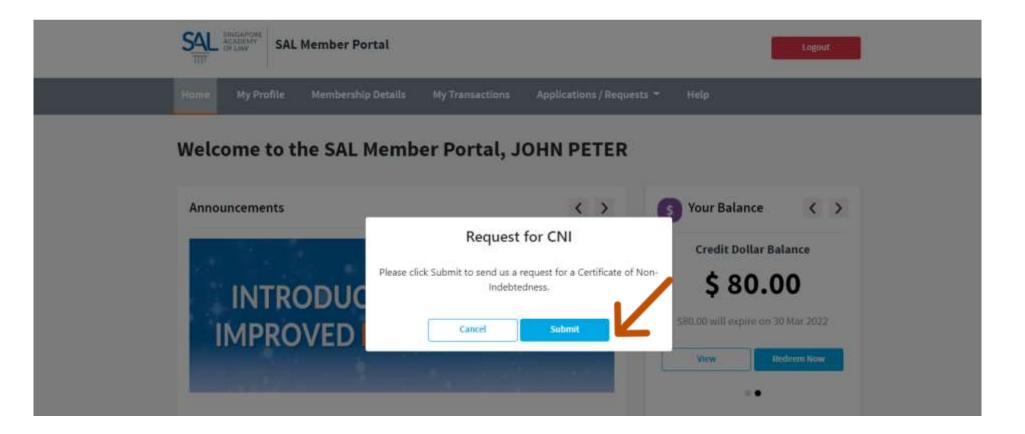
Click Application / Requests and select Request for CNI

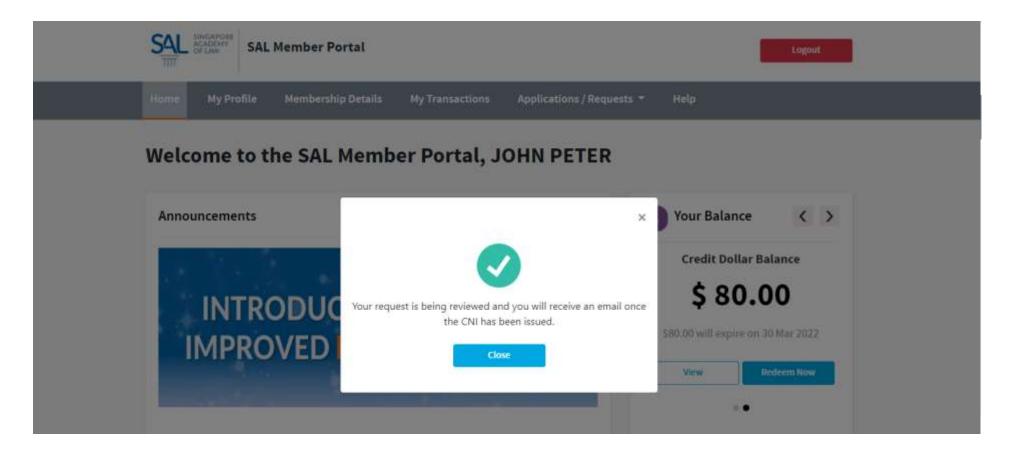
